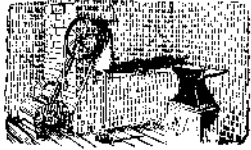

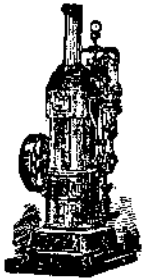
Roots' Rotary Hand Blower,

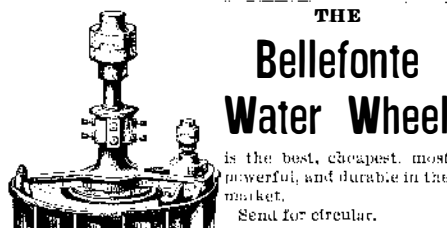
